

DYU Regulations for International Student Admissions PhD Program, College of Biotechnology & Bioresources

PhD Program, College of Biotechnology & Bioresources, Da-Yeh University Regulations for International Student Admissions

Approved by the Institute Affairs Meeting on May 02, 2013

Article 1 These regulations are formulated in accordance with Article 6 of [MOE Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan](#), and Article 7 of [DYU Admission Guidelines for International Students](#).

Article 2 All applicants shall submit the following documents to DYU before the designated application deadline.

- A. Application form (attached with a recent two-inch head shot photo).
- B. Graduation certificate and full transcript of records: The highest degree diploma verified with official stamps by the issued school (a notarized copy of translation in English or Chinese is also required). The official transcripts in English by years verified with official stamps by the issued school.
 - a. Academic credentials from Mainland China: The Regulations Governing the Accreditation of Schools in Mainland China shall apply.
 - b. Academic credentials from Hong Kong or Macao: Academic Credential Verification and Accreditation Methods adopted in Hong Kong and Macao shall apply.
 - c. Academic credentials from other areas :
 - i. Academic credentials earned at overseas Taiwan schools or Taiwan schools in Mainland China shall be regarded as the same as those at domestic schools with equivalent levels.
 - ii. Academic credentials referred in the preceding 2 Items shall be subject to the Regulations Regarding the Assessment and Recognition of Foreign Academic Credentials for Institutions of Higher Education. However, academic credentials earned from institutes or branches established in Mainland China by foreign schools shall require public notarization in Mainland China and be verified and examined by an institute established or appointed by, or a private agency commissioned by the Executive Yuan.
- C. Financial proof that shows financial sustainability for study in Taiwan, or proof of full scholarship provided by a government agency, university, college, or private organization.
- D. Declaration: DYU reviews the application documents without verification by overseas

consulates, representative offices, agencies of the country or other bodies authorized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (hereinafter referred to as ‘Overseas Agencies’) or institutes established or appointed by, or a private agency commissioned by the Executive Yuan as prescribed in subparagraphs B and C of the preceding paragraph may request for verification by an Overseas Agencies. If the said documents have been verified, DYU may request examination of the documents.

Article 3 Qualification and required certificates or documents:

A. Qualification:

- a. International students with a Master’s degree or equivalent education level are eligible to apply for PhD program
- b. Language proficiency for Chinese is required (Chinese listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills are assessed and recognized by DYU recruitment committee).

B. Required certificates or documents:

- a. Autobiography in Chinese and English
- b. Master thesis and relevant academic publications
- c. Study plan
- d. Full transcript of records (College and above)
- e. Any additional documents which may favor the application (Chinese language proficiency proof, certificate of Chinese-taught course study, recommendation letters, works....)

Article 4 Those applicants that qualify through the review or screening process will be granted admission by DYU recruitment committee.

Article 5 If there are regulations not fully stated here, the Ministry of Education regulations ([MOE Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan](#)) and DYU regulations ([DYU Admission Guidelines for International Students](#)) shall be followed.

Article 6 These regulations and any amendments hereto shall be approved at the Institute Affairs Meetings before taking effect.
